Minutes of 44th Executive Committee (EC) meeting of National Mineral Exploration and Development Trust (NMEDT) held on 18.9.2025 at 15:00 hours under Chairmanship of Shri Piyush Goyal, Chairman, EC/Secretary, Mines

The 44th meeting of the Executive Committee of NMEDT was convened under the Chairmanship of the Secretary, Mines, on 18.9.2025, to discuss the proposal of formation of a Committee/Sub-committee of the Executive Committee, NMEDT, to deliberate, scrutinize, and approve the project proposals recommended by the Technical cum Cost Committees (TCCs) up to the financial limit of Rs. 20 crore per project under Rules 10 and 11 of the NMET Rules, 2015. The list of participants is annexed as Annexure-1.

The Director General NMDT, informed to the Executive Committee, that pursuant to the amendments made to the MMDR Act in 2025, the scope of the Trust has widened. Now, NMEDT will also fund exploration in offshore areas within India and outside India for regional and detailed exploration and development of mines and minerals in the prescribed manner. Consequently, the National Mineral Exploration Trust has been renamed as the National Mineral Exploration and Development Trust. Considering the enhanced scope of work, it is anticipated that there would be a substantial increase in the number of exploration proposals in NMEDT. The focus is on expediting the exploration work by enhancing the ecosystem for greater participation of the private sector, besides the public sector and promoting ease of doing business by granting faster clearances to the projects. The matter was discussed in the Ministry of Mines, and it was decided that there would be a weekly meeting of both the TCCs. Further, to fast-track the approval for the proposals recommended by the TCCs, a committee/sub-committee be constituted, and accordingly, the 44th EC meeting was called on 18.09.2025.

The EC was informed by DG NMEDT, that Rule 11 sub rule (1) of The NMET rules, 2015 provides that

"The Executive Committee may constitute committees or sub-committees to undertake such tasks that may be assigned or delegated by the Executive Committee to such committees and sub-committees."

Further, Rule 10 sub-rule (4) of The NMET rules, 2015 provides that

"The Executive Committee shall formulate and finalise the scheme for delegation of financial powers."

The proposal was deliberated at length by the Executive Committee.

a. It was also informed that the NMEDT is a statutory, autonomous body under the Ministry of Mines. The members were requested to share their views with regard to the Chairperson of this proposed committee or sub-committee and its composition.

<u>Views of the members of EC</u>: It would be better if DG, NMEDT is Chairperson of this committee keeping in mind the autonomous character of the NMEDT.

b. Additional Secretary & Financial Advisor (AS&FA), Ministry of Mines observed that (i) it would not be advisable to have a representative of IFD, Mines as a member of the committee of an autonomous body (ii) the composition of the committee should be similar to that of the Executive Committee with appropriate level (iii) the decision of the EC should be got approved from Hon'ble Union Minister of Mines.

<u>Views of the members of EC</u>: (i) NMEDT is a statutory body under the Ministry of Mines. The Executive Committee of NMEDT also includes AS/JS&FA as a member, and therefore, a representative from IFD, Mines, should be included in the proposed committee to provide a financial perspective on the projects. Since there is no officer of Director/DS rank (Finance) presently posted in NMEDT, therefore it was decided that the Cost Accounts Officer, NMEDT should be also included in the proposed committee; (ii) as far as the composition of the committee about other members is concerned, the observation made by AS&FA was agreed to; (iii) rule 11 sub-rule (1) of the NMET Rules, 2015 authorizes the Executive Committee to constitute committees or sub-committees. However, the Secretary, Mines, directed that approval of the EC decision be obtained from the Hon'ble Union Minister of Mines.

c. DG, GSI suggested that the proposed committee should have Director, Mission-II of GSI as a member instead of DDG, PSS.

Views of the members of EC: The suggestion made by DG, GSI was agreed to.

d. The Principal Secretary, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh suggested that the proposed committee may be named as Project Sanctioning Committee.

<u>Views of the members of EC</u>: The suggestion made by the Principal Secretary, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh was agreed to.

In view of the deliberations and observations made by the members of the Executive Committee, the following committee named as Project Sanctioning Committee, consisting of members mentioned below, is approved:
