OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Constitution of Project Sanctioning Committee of National Mineral Exploration and Development Trust (NMEDT)-reg.

Recent amendments in the MMDR Act in 2025 have widened the scope of NMEDT to fund exploration in offshore areas within India and outside India for regional and detailed exploration and development of mines and minerals, in the prescribed manner. To expedite the work as per the widened scope by fast-tracking the approval of projects, the Executive Committee of NMEDT has constituted a Project Sanctioning Committee with a financial power to sanction projects with a financial limit of Rs. 20 crore for each project.

- 2. The Committee has been constituted under Rule 11 sub rule (1) of NMET Rules, 2015 which provides that "The Executive Committee may constitute committees or sub-committees to undertake such tasks that may be assigned or delegated by the Executive Committee to such committees and sub-committees" and has been delegated financial power under Rule 10 sub-rule (4) of the NMET Rules, 2015 which provides that, "The Executive Committee shall formulate and finalise the scheme for delegation of financial powers".
- 3. The Project Sanctioning Committee of NMEDT shall consist of following members:

The terms of reference of the Project Sanctioning Committee of NMEDT are as under:

- i. The Committee will consider project proposals having financial value up to ₹ 20 Crore, which have been duly recommended by the TCCs, for approval. While approving project proposals, all extant financial guidelines of the Government of India would be followed by the committee. Project proposals above ₹ 20 Crore would be recommended by the Committee, for approval by the Executive Committee.
- ii. The project proposals relating to mineral exploration, procurement of equipment/machinery/software, baseline geoscience survey, special studies proposals, project proposals recommended under S&T Prism Scheme etc. would be considered by the Committee for decision regarding approval.
- Proposals for release of grants/incentives to State Governments and other exploration agencies as per the approved schemes of NMEDT would also be considered by the Committee for approval.
- iv. Proposals for cost revision and timeline extension of ongoing projects beyond the permissible limits of TCCs would also be considered by the Committee for approval.
- v. The proposals approved by the Committee will be presented in the Integrated Finance Division of the Ministry of Mines for financial concurrence, to release the funds against approved projects.
- vi. The Committee may co-opt the Chairmen of the Technical-cum-Cost Committees of NMEDT or any other officer or technical expert as special invitee for further deliberations.
- vii. The Committee shall place a comprehensive report before the Executive Committee periodically.
- viii. The quorum of the Committee shall be complete if not less than 7 members are present and attending the meeting either physically or electronically through any channel of communication.

4. The Committee shall meet at least once in a month and as many times required depending on the availability of sufficient number of project proposals recommended by the TCCs.

This issues with the approval of Hon'ble Union Minister of Mines/Chairman, Governing Body of National Mineral Exploration and Development Trust.
