- 4. The grant shall be subject to following conditions:
  - i. JNARDDC shall follow the guidelines issued by MoM for the S&T-PRISM Component of Science and Technology Programme of Ministry of Mines before release of grants to Startups / MSMEs.
- ii. The grant shall not be diverted to or utilized for the purpose other than that for which it entrusted to another institution or organization.

  The grant shall be subject to the purpose of the purpo
- iii. The grant shall be subject to the provision of GFRs 2017 (Rule 228 to 245) as well as other rules/instructions/guidelines of Government of India.
- iv. The accounts of the project shall be open for audit by the sanctioning authority and also by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Mines as per Rule 236 of the GFR v.
   v. The grantee organization will related to the project shall be open for audit by C&AG of India.
- v. The grantee organization will submit their accounts for audit promptly whenever required so.
- vi. The Implementing Agency has to abide by Terms & Conditions for Grant-in-Aid as per Annexure II of the S&T-PRISM Guidelines.

- 5. The amount of ₹ 1,91,12,000/- (Rupees one crore ninety one lakhs twelve thousand only) will be debitable under Demand No. 69 of Ministry of Mines for the year 2023-24 as under:-

- 6. Certified that the pattern of assistance under which the Grant-in-aid has been sanctioned has the prior approval of Ministry of Finance. As per GFR 2017-Rule 238(1), the Utilization Certificate in form No. 12-A is to be furnished by the Implementing Agency. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within twelve months of the closure of the financial year by the Implementing Agency.
- 7. In terms of GFR 2017 Rule 235 and 236 (1), the Implementing Agency is required to furnish to the Accounts Officer a set of audited statement of accounts, after utilization of the grants-in-aid or whenever called for. Further, the accounts of the Implementing Agency shall be open to inspection, both by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Mines, whenever the Centre is called upon to do so.
- 8. To monitor the physical progress, technical progress and financial progress of S&T-PRISM project, Institute is required to submit the half yearly progress report on expiry of every six months from the date of sanction of the project till its completion to the Department as per the proforma. The Institute will be responsible for fruitful completion of the project with due information to Ministry of Mines.
- 9. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grant shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-Aid.
- 10. DDO (Drawing and Disbursing Officer) will act as DDO for the purpose of drawl of ₹ 1,91,12,000/- (Rupees one crore ninety one lakhs twelve thousand only) for payment to the Jawaharlal Nehru Aluminium Research Development and Design Centre through RTGS in Industrial Development Bank of India IDBI Bank, Civil Lines, Main Branch, Nagpur-440001 IFSC Code IBKL0000041 A/c Current Bank MICR No. 440259002 and Beneficiary Account No. 0041102000047083.
