Subject: Approval of mineral exploration project and release of 1st 40% Advance from Grant-in-Aid (General) for the project "Preliminary Exploration (G-3) of Limestone in Bandha Block (3.54 sq. km) and Jamuniya Block (3.68 sq. km) in District Satna, Madhya Pradesh."

Agency: - MECL

On the recommendation of Technical-cum-Cost Committee (TCC) of NMEDT, the Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) in its 3rd meeting held on 13.12.2025 has approved mineral exploration project to be executed by MECL. The details of the project are given below: -

2. The mineral exploration project will be funded by NMEDT as per the cost recommended by the TCC and approved by the Project Sanctioning Committee. The Implementing Agency shall complete the same as per the approved cost estimates and time schedule, enclosed in Annexure, as summarized below: -

•	Field Mobilization	1 st month (up to 07.01.26)
•	Exploration (Mapping, Sampling, Survey, Drilling, Camp winding)	1 st to 10 th month (up to 07.10.26)
•	Laboratory Studies	8 th to 10 th month (up to 07.10.26)
•	Report Writing with Peer Review and submission to NMEDT	10 th month (up to 07.10.2026)

3. The Implementing Agency shall submit progress on monthly basis to NMEDT Secretariat. The TCC, NMEDT shall review the progress of project and provide update to the Project Sanctioning Committee.

4. Sanction is hereby conveyed for release of the 1st instalment of 40% of the approved project cost i.e. ₹87,77,683/- (₹ Eighty seven lakh seventy seven thousand six hundred eighty three only) as an advance in terms of conditions stipulated in this office letter no. 42/1/2017-NMET/176 dated 16th December 2021 and letter no. 42/1/2017-NMET/217 dated 19th January 2022 regarding "*Release of funds to State Government / NEAs for mineral exploration*".
5. The expenditure will be debited to '2853' Non-Ferrous Mining and Metallurgical Industries (Major Head) 02-Regulation and Development of Mines (Sub-Major head) 102-Mineral Exploration (Minor Head) 05-National Mineral Exploration Trust Fund Activities (Sub-Head) 00- National Mineral Exploration Trust Fund Activities (Detailed-Head) 05.00. 31-Grant-in-aid (General) under Demand No. 69, Ministry of Mines during the financial year 2025-26.
6. Certified that the pattern of assistance, under which the Grants-in-Aid (General) has been sanctioned, has the prior approval of Ministry of Finance.
7. MECL is a registered agency on EAT module of PFMS. In terms of **Rule 230, 235, 236 and 238 of GFR**, MECL should maintain subsidiary accounts of the Government Grants and furnish the same to the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry. The account shall be open to inspection by the Sanctioning Authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Mines, whenever the Organization is called upon to do so.
8. The exploration agency has to furnish the utilization certificate in respect of amount disbursed as Grant-in-aid for the project on utilization of disbursed amount or after completion of one year from the date of disbursement of advance, whichever is earlier. The next instalment of advance will be released after submission of utilization certificate and progress report in respect of the 1st instalment.
9. The uploading of Geological Report (GR) on NGDR portal is sole responsibility of the exploration agency. The final payment will be made only after receiving the confirmation of the same. The screenshot/ acknowledgement of successful uploading of GR (with admin approval) is to be submitted to NMEDT with the final bill.
10. Shri Roshan Lal Meena, Section Officer in the Ministry will be the Drawing and Disbursing Officer for this purpose. It is requested that the payment of ₹87,77,683/- (₹ Eighty seven lakh seventy seven thousand six hundred eighty three only) may kindly be made to the Mineral Exploration and Consultancy Limited, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Bhawan, Seminary Hills, Nagpur- 440006 through RTGS in State Bank of India, Industrial Finance Branch, Nagpur (IFSC Code- SBIN0000432, Current Account No. 10374783387)
